## **Humanitarian Priorities in the Regions**

Cookies are small text files that store the platform on your computer to recognize it. The information contained in the cookies is used to determine whether you are logged in, or what data you have already entered, information about the use of the web pages. Cookies are automatically accepted for most web browsers. By changing the settings of your browser you can avoid this. You can remove cookies stored on your PC at any time by deleting the temporary Internet files (browser bar "Extras  $\rightarrow$  Internet options").

Specifically, the following cookies are stored:

- PHPSESSID: This cookie saves a reference value to the current session of the user at the server in order to be able to assign registration or payment processes to the respective user. Closing the browser deletes this cookie.
- **hl:** This cookie stores the currently selected language. It is deleted 24 hours after the last page access.
- **device\_view**: This cookie is created by the Mobile Detect library (<a href="https://github.com/suncat2000/MobileDetectBundle/">https://github.com/suncat2000/MobileDetectBundle/</a>) The library recognizes the current device used to access the website (mobile, tablet, desktop) and saves this value in a cookie. The cookie is automatically deleted after 30 days.
- **cookieconsent\_status:** This cookie is only set when you have agreed to the use of cookies and prevents the cookie information from being displayed again.
