- **CAMES – African and Malagasy Council for Higher Education**

CAMES includes 19 member countries spread across West Africa, Central Africa, the Great Lakes region and the Indian Ocean.

- **SADC – Southern African Development Community**

SADC is a regional economic community comprising 16 member states in Southern Africa.
